## How to pay road tolls for visitors

### Pass through AutoPASS toll roads without stopping

AutoPASS is the electronic payment system for toll fees in Norway. All toll stations are automatic, with the exception of Atlanterhavstunnelen. Pass through without stopping and receive an invoice after your journey.

### Pay road tolls one of the following ways:

#### Electronic tag and AutoPASS agreement

- Norwegian and foreign vehicles

AutoPASS toll tag by entering into an agreement with any toll road operator that issues tags. Visit [www.autopass.no](http://www.autopass.no) to enter into an AutoPASS agreement.

#### Visitors' Payment via EPC

- Foreign vehicles only

Foreign registered vehicles, without a toll tag, will be invoiced by Euro Parking Collection plc (EPC). To make the payment process faster and easier, and to get access to your payment details, you may register your foreign vehicle with an EPC account before your journey.



# How to register and pay via EPC

1. Register your foreign owned / rented / leased vehicle at [www.epcplc.com](http://www.epcplc.com)
2. Drive through the AutoPASS toll lanes without stopping.
3. The invoice will be sent to you, based on the information you have registered.
4. Pay the invoice online by payment card or, in most countries, at a local bank. If you need assistance, contact EPC, offering customer service in most European languages.
