

Claims

1. A composition for use in masking the odor of a fish semiochemical in water,
5 wherein the attraction between an ectoparasite and a fish in water is reduced,
characterized in that the composition comprises a compound, and is added to said
water or is administered to a fish in said water, wherein said compound is diallyl
sulfide, and wherein said fish is a Salmonidae.
- 10 2. A composition according to claim 1, wherein said fish semiochemical is
isophorone.
3. A composition according to claim 1, wherein said fish semiochemical is
1-Octen-3-ol or 6-methyl-5-hepten-2-one.
- 15 4. A composition according to claim 1, wherein said Salmonidae is selected from
the group consisting of Atlantic salmon, Coho salmon, Chinook, rainbow trout, Arctic
char and other farmed salmon species.
- 20 5. A composition according to claim 1, wherein said parasite is sea lice
(*Lepeophtheirus salmonis*, *Caligus* sp.).
