We write with reference to the office action dated 2022.09.18 for the above mentioned case where it was concluded that the pending claims are both novel and inventive. The application was found to contain certain formal deficiencies that were requested corrected before the pending application can be brought to a grant.

The applicant wishes to proceed with the application by addressing the formal deficiencies as indicated below.

Formal deficiencies:

- The examiner pointed out that the prior art documents D2 and D3 are not mentioned in the description as required by the Norwegian patent guidelines Part C, chap. III, point. 2.1.

The applicant has now included a description of D2 and D3 in the background section of the application, and thus respectfully submits that the application now is in compliance with the Norwegian patent guidelines Part C, chap. III, point. 2.1.

- The examiner points out that the independent claim is not drafted in two-part form according to the Norwegian patent guidelines Part C, chap. III, point. 2.3.

As indicated above, we have decided to add a short mention of the prior art documents D1-D3 in the description, which according to the Norwegian patent guidelines Part C, chap. III, point 2.3.3 and incorporated legal practice by the NIPO renders it unnecessary to construct the claims in two-part form.

An amended description taking into account the above amendments are enclosed this letter in a marked and clean version.

Translation of the claims into Norwegian:
